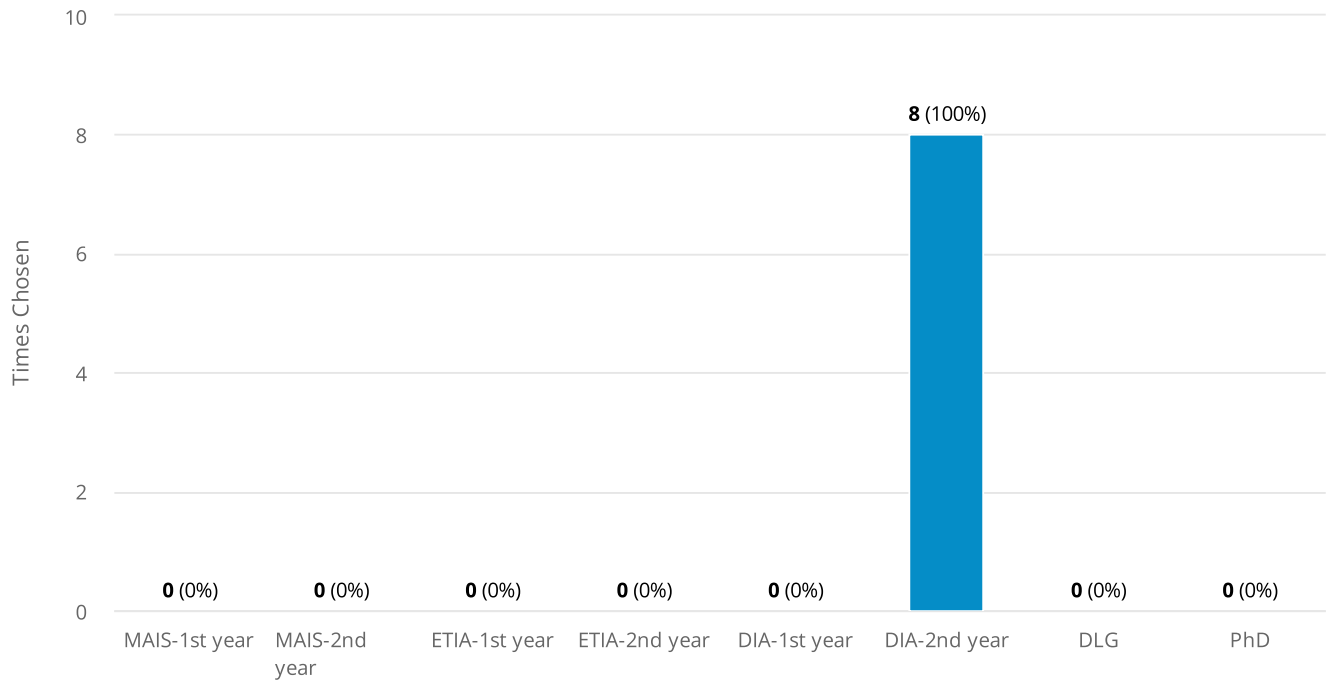

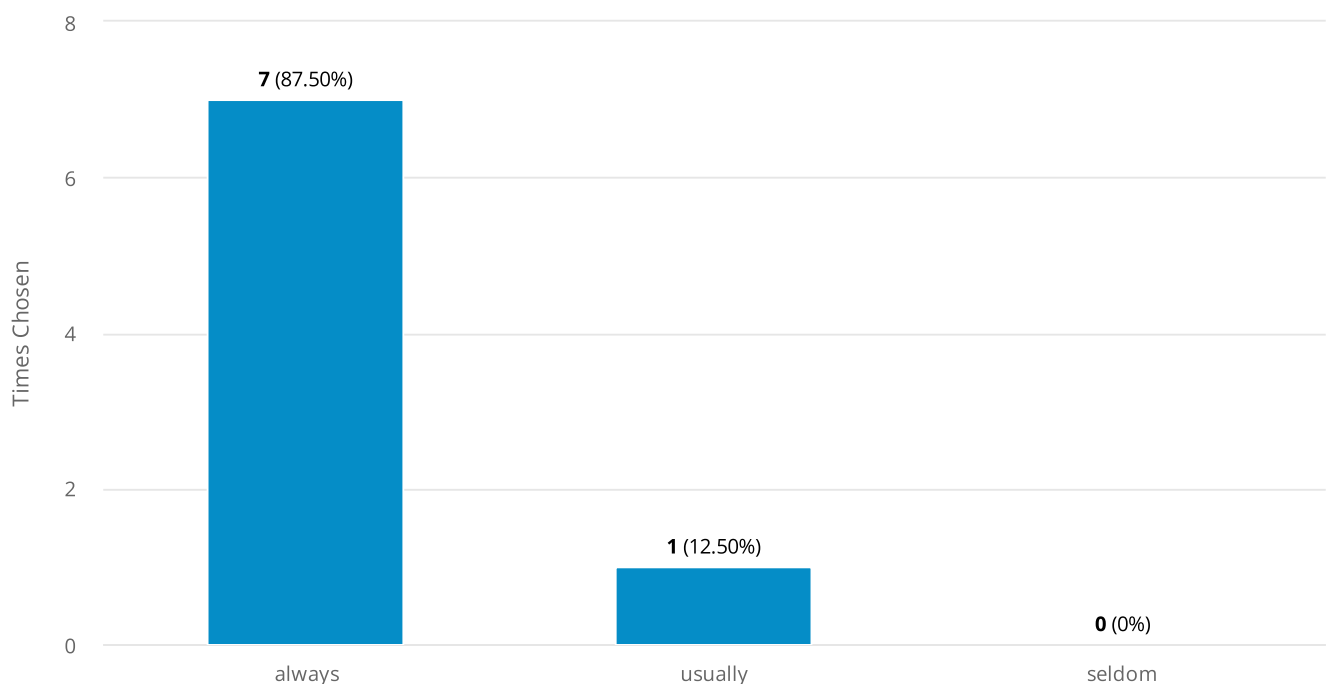

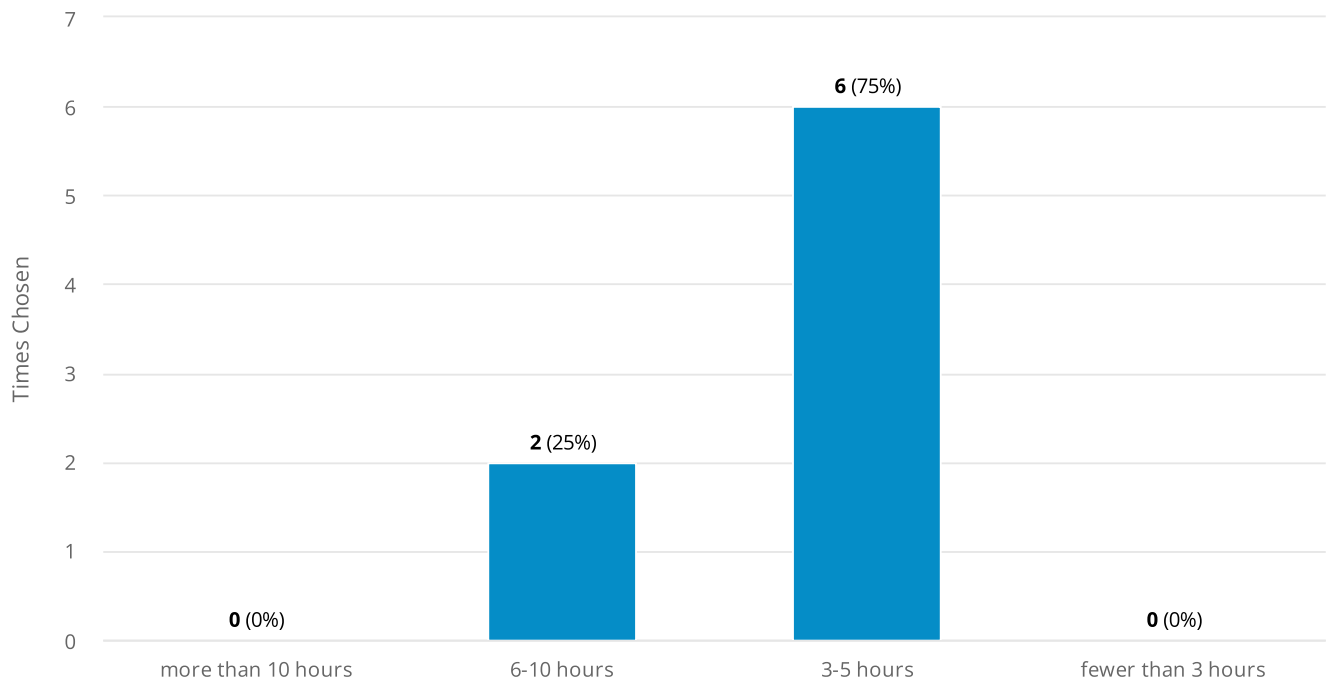
How often have you attended the classes?

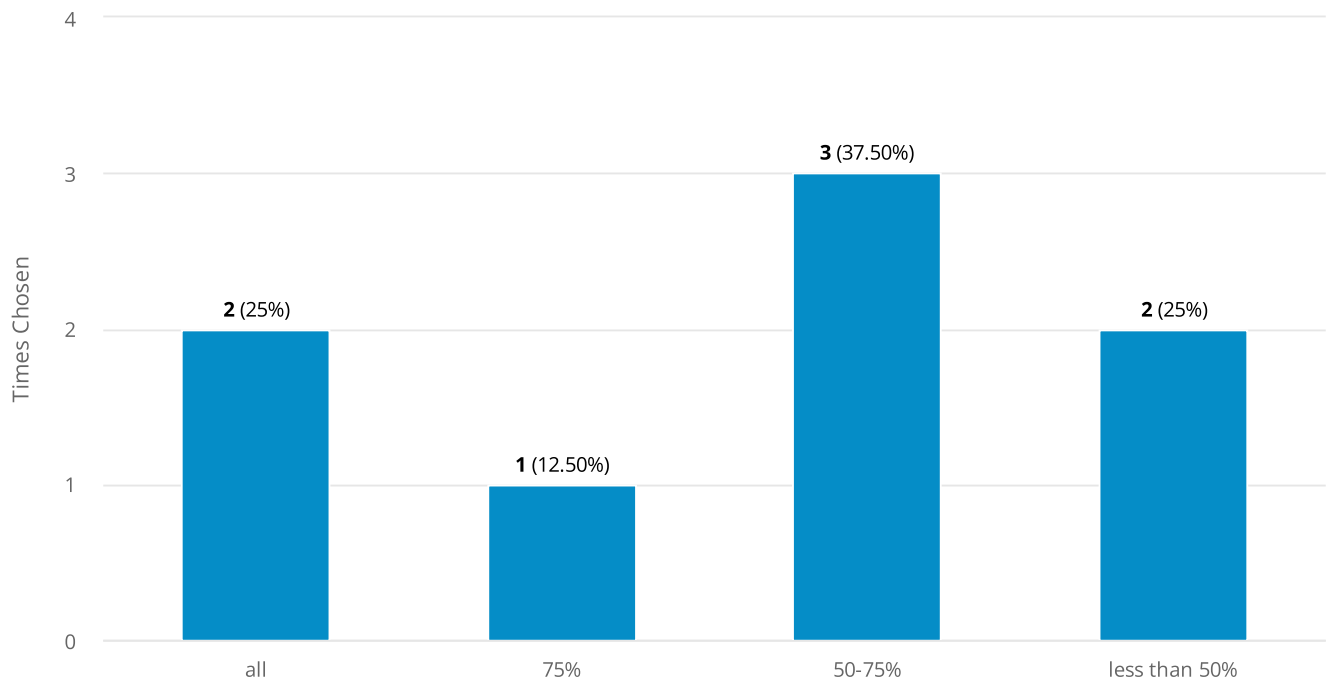

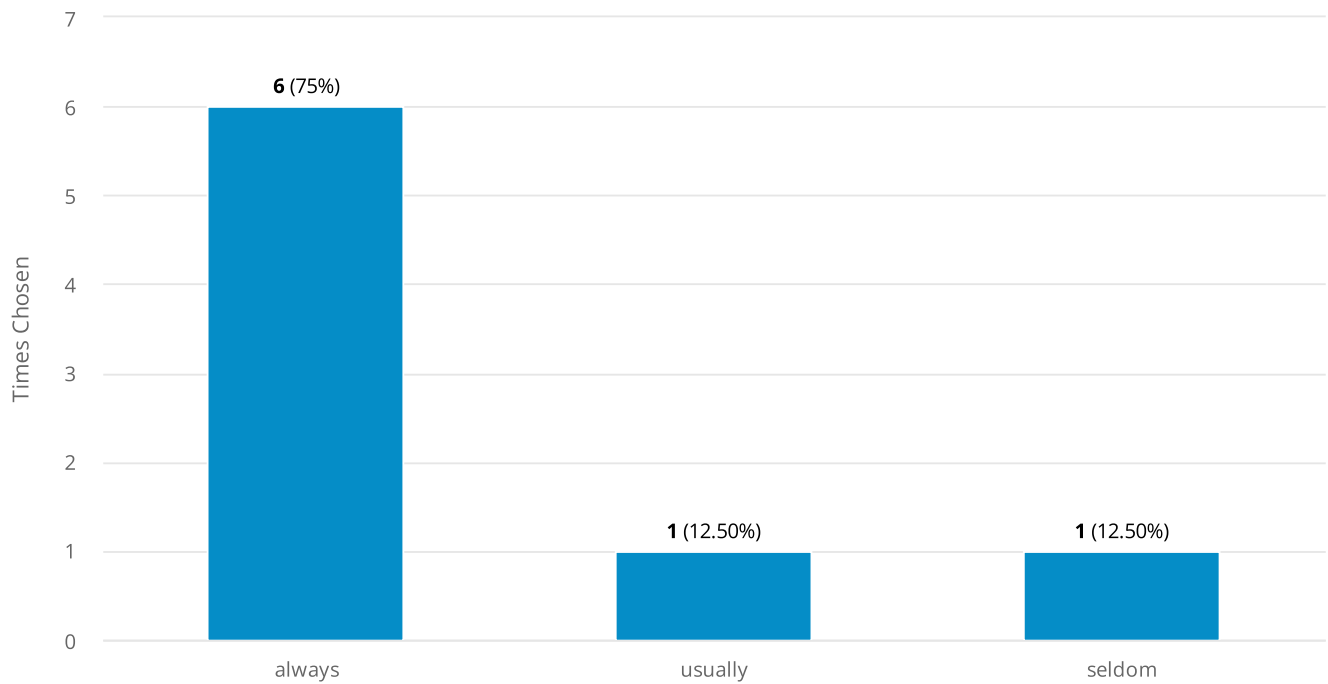

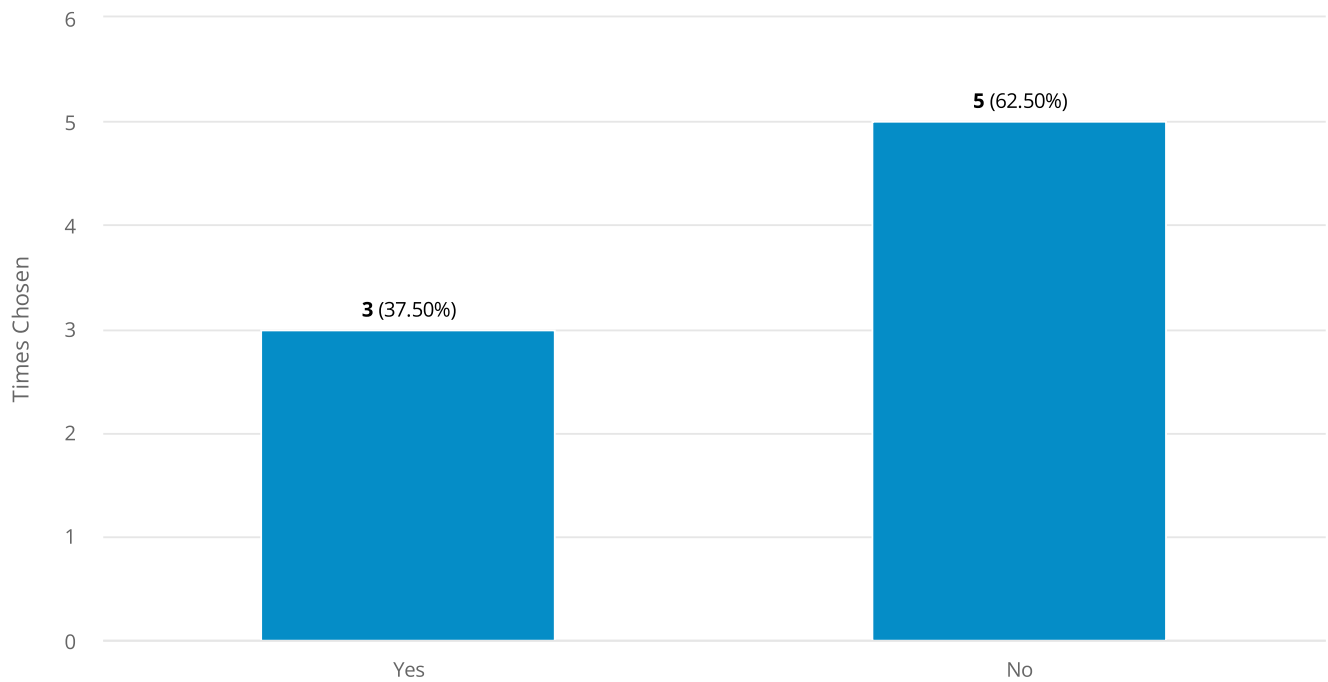

I liked the approach when we had a couple of discussion questions plus short quiz during the class. It really helped to systematize the information from the readings and slides.

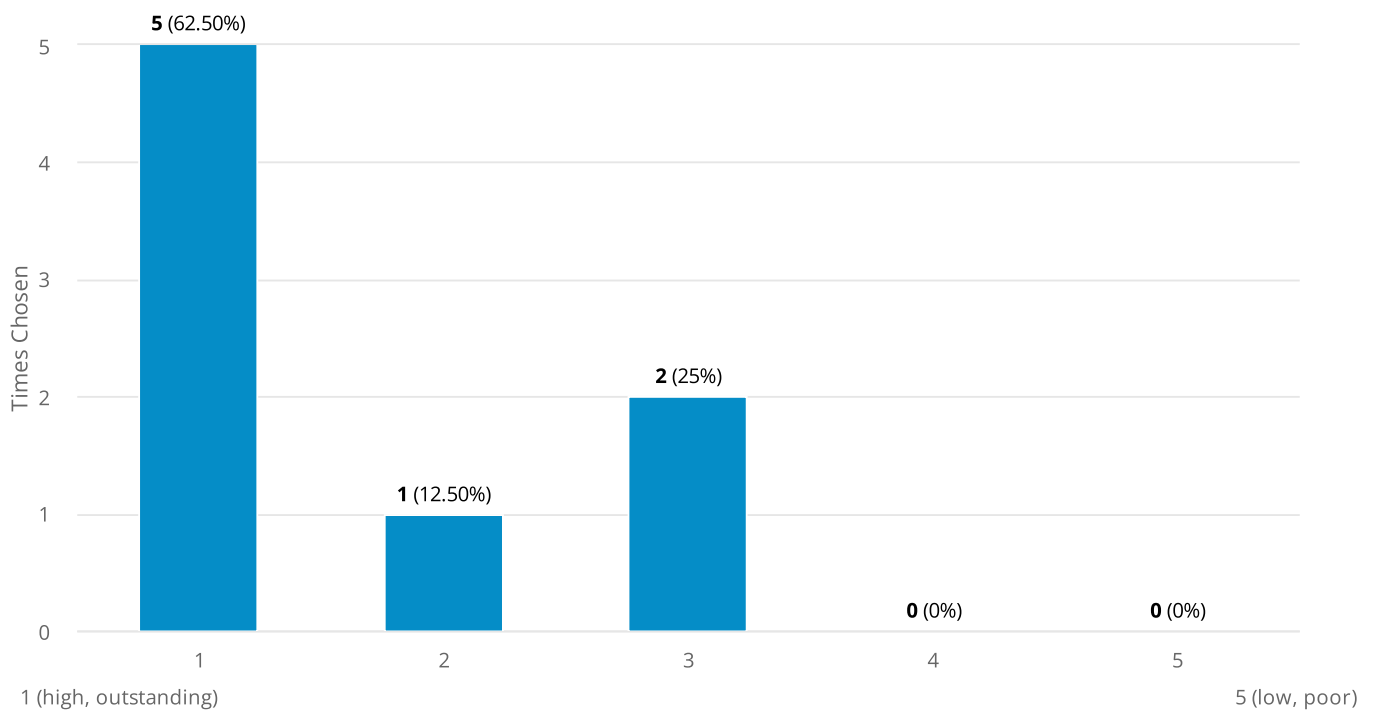

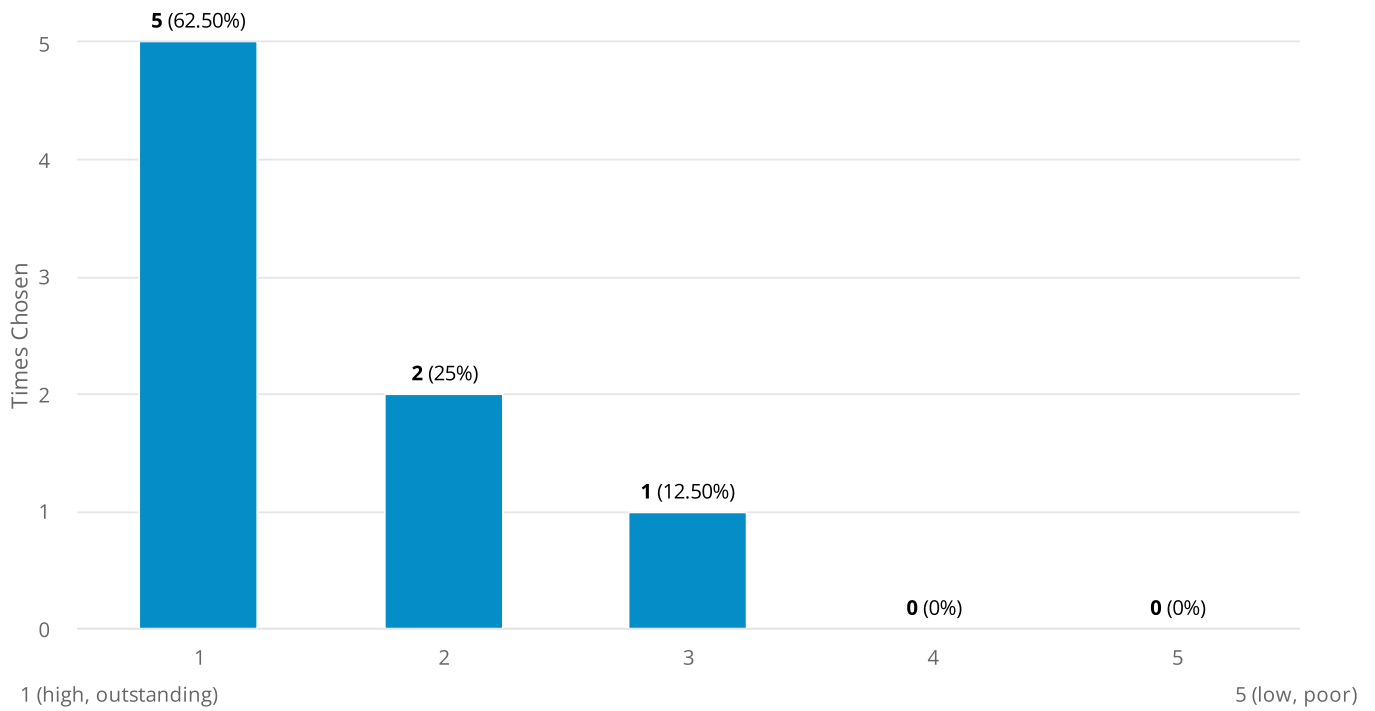
To what degree have the Syllabus content and course organisation been clear?

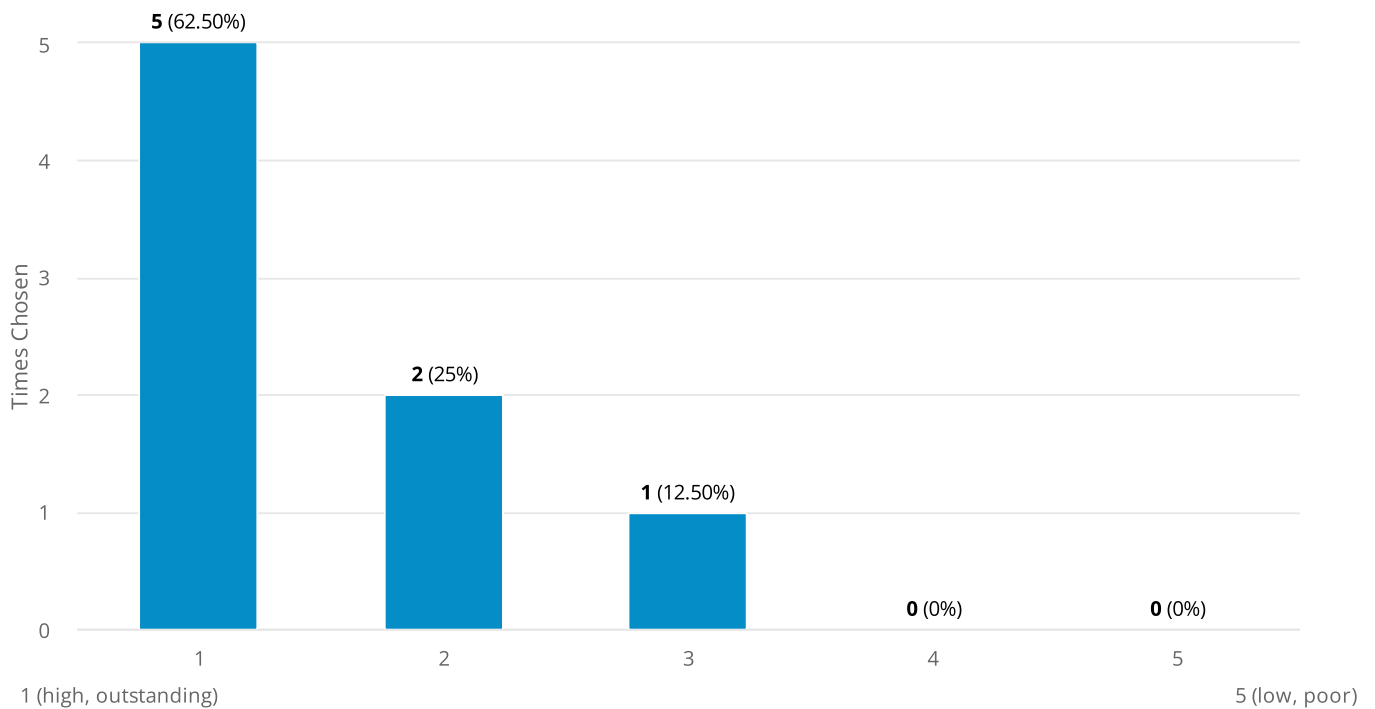
To what degree have the stated objectives of the course been met?

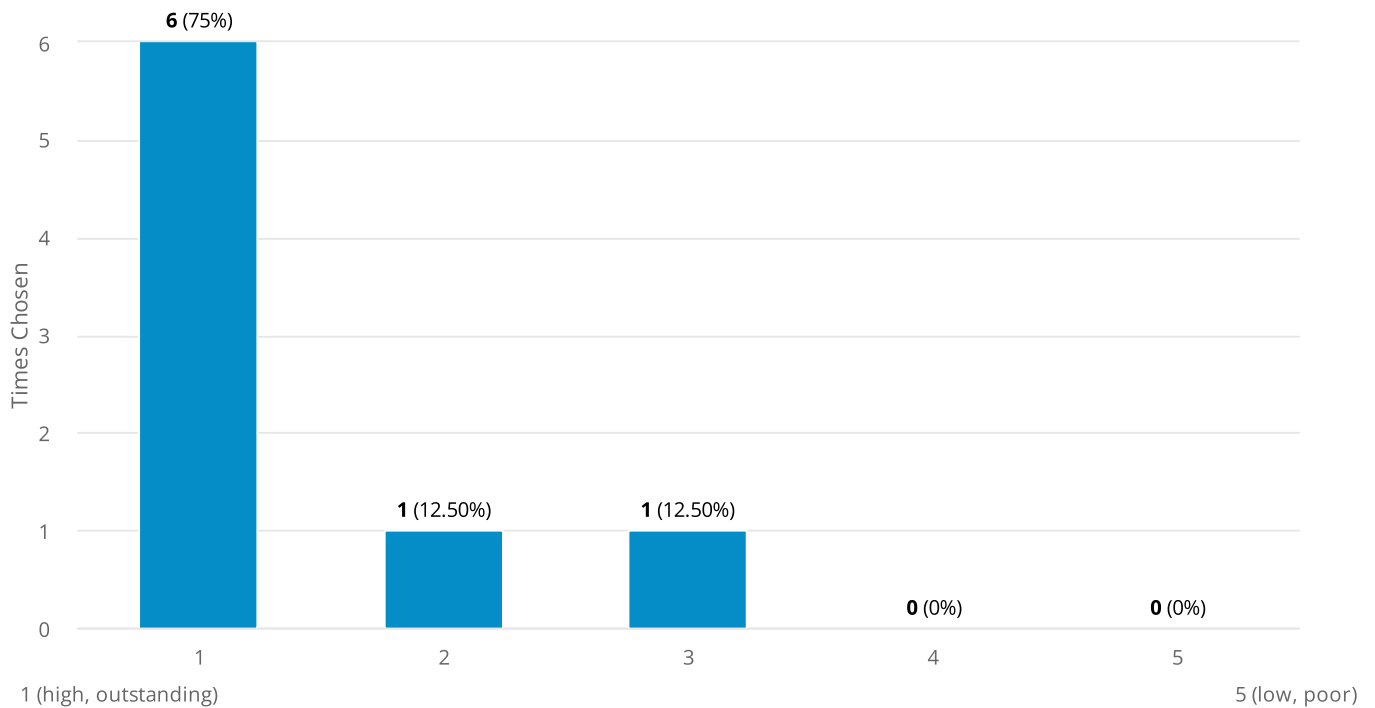

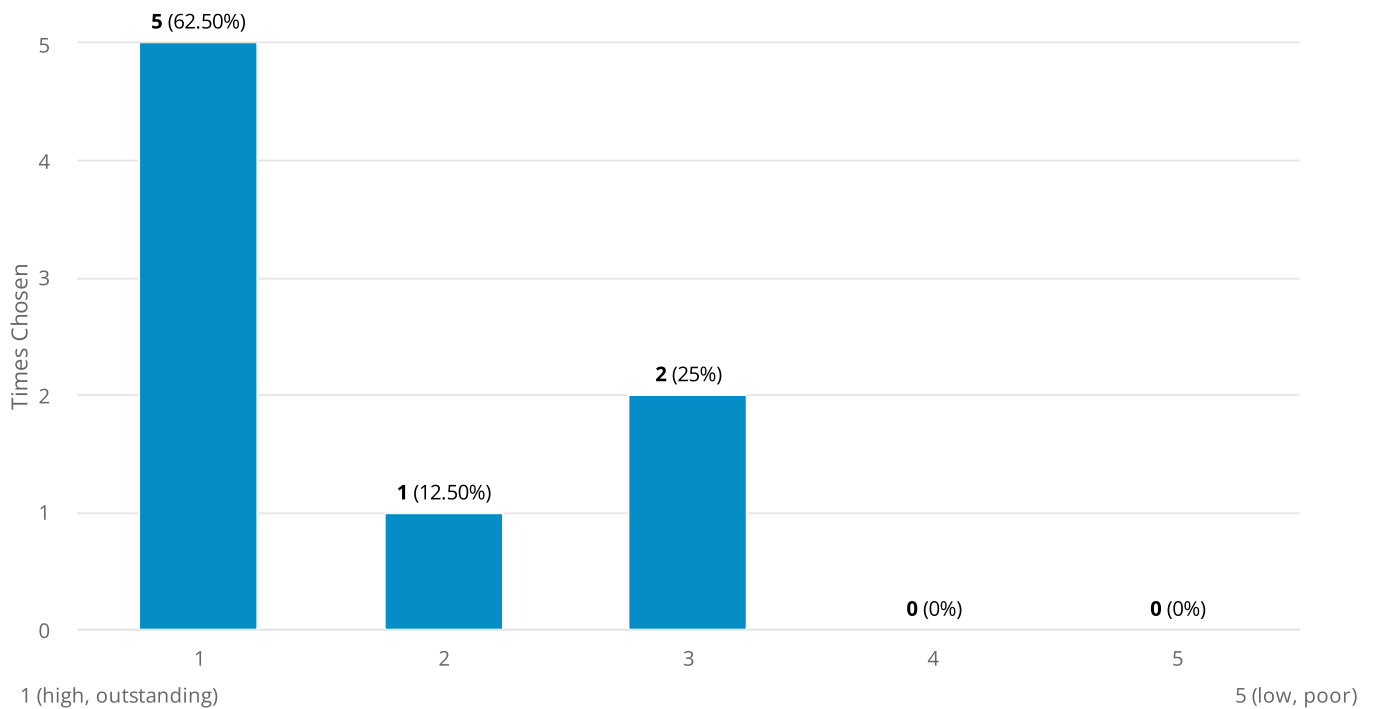

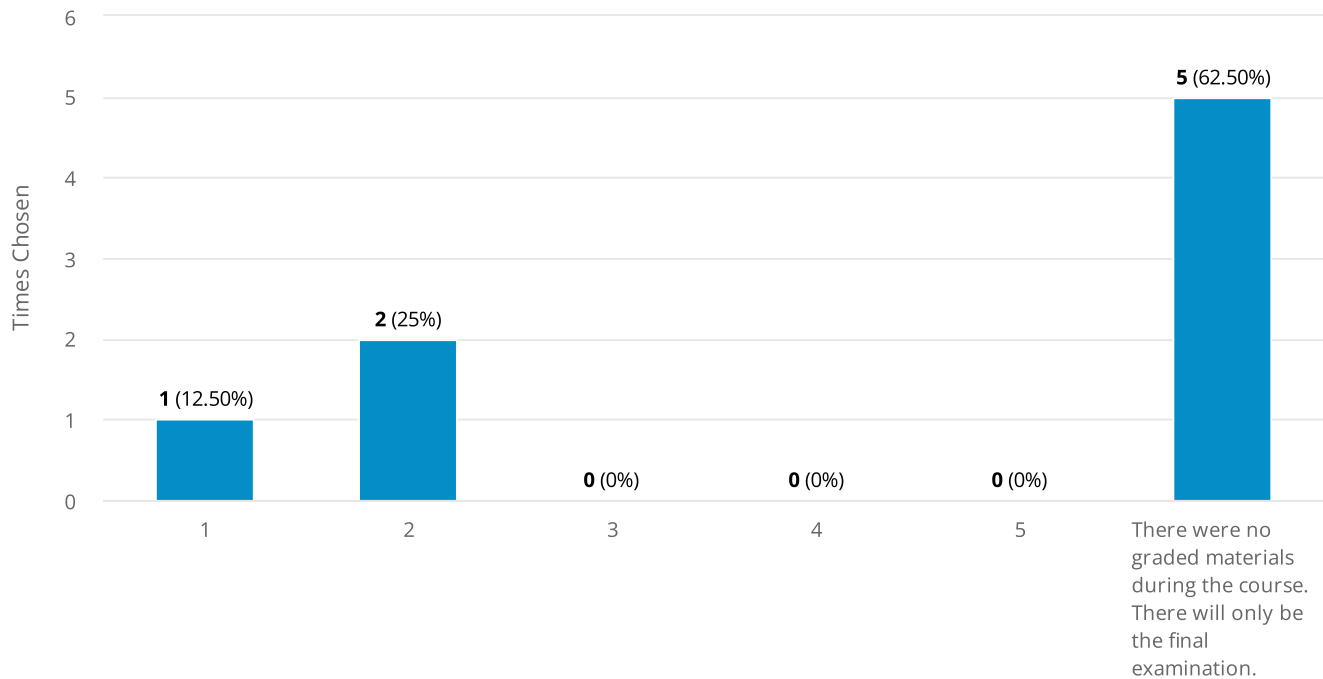

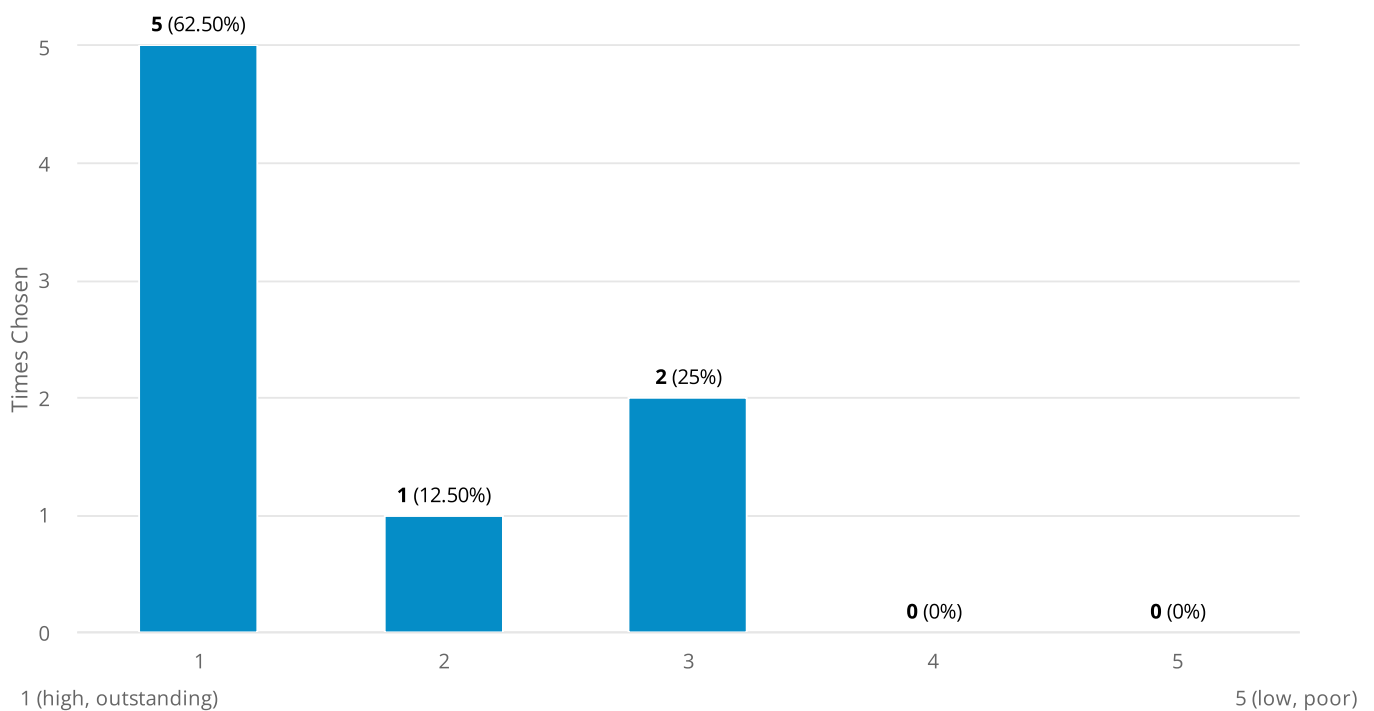

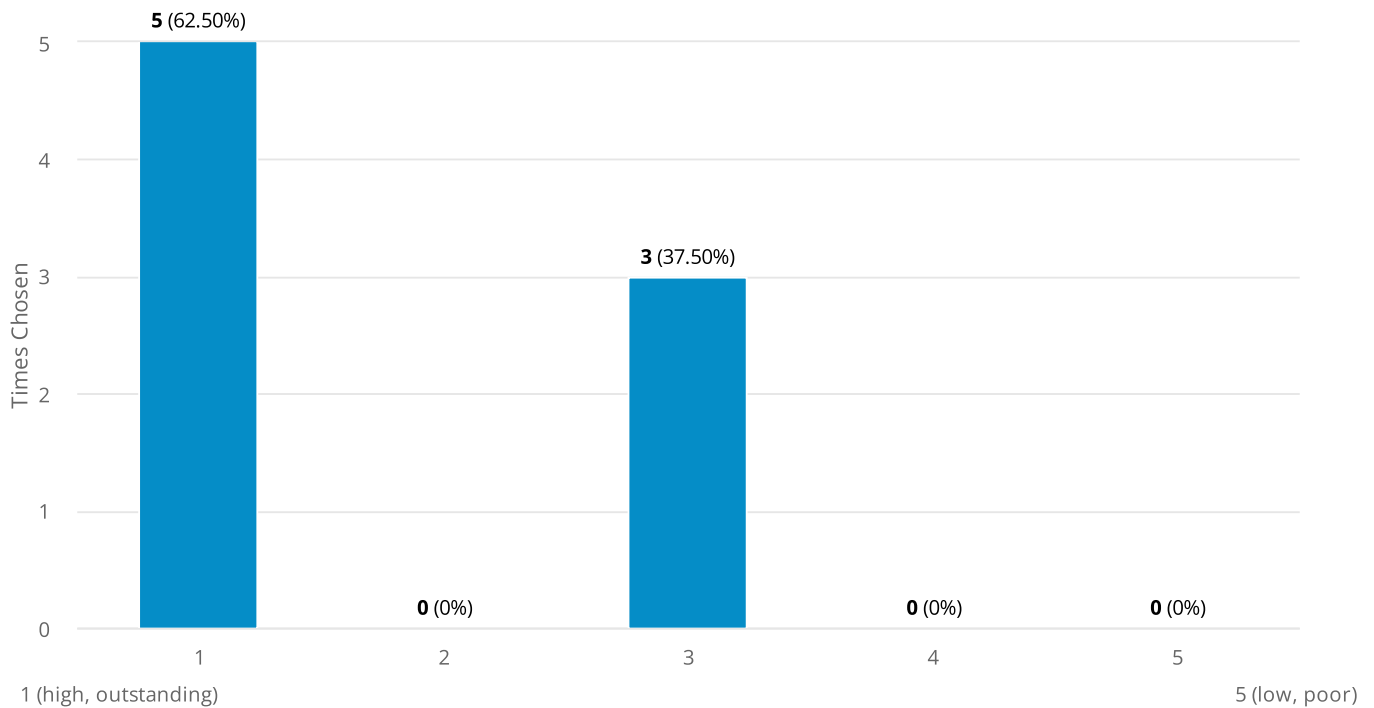

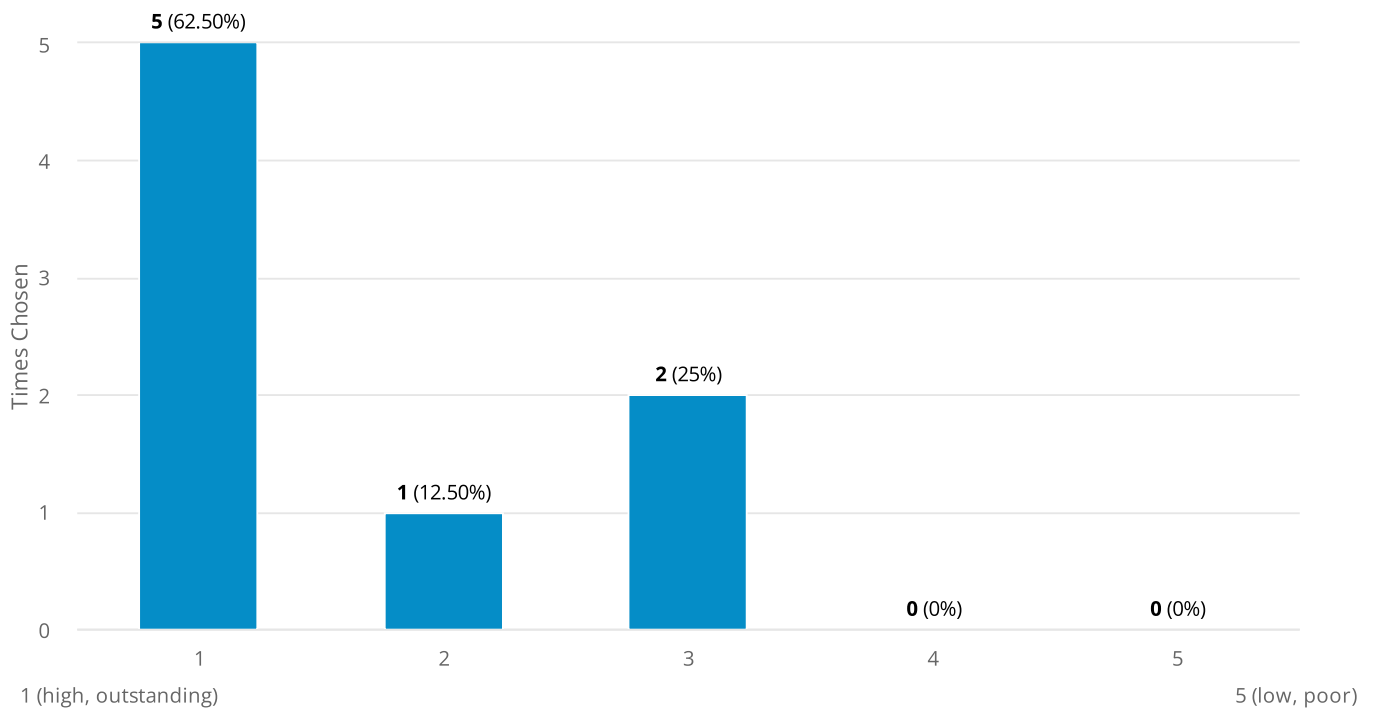

A very nice introductory course to Machine Learning. Just one addition from my side: I think it would be better if we had some practice throughout the course, not just a presentation on our final paper during the last session.

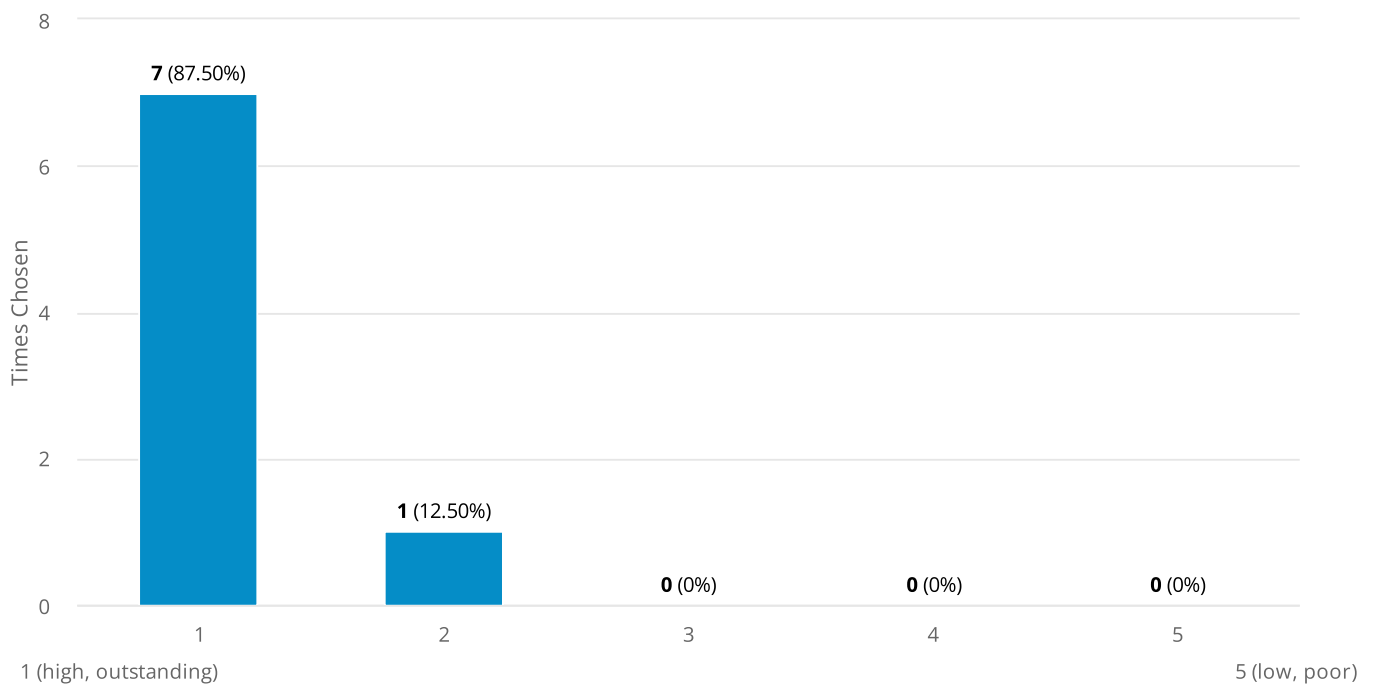
The material is very complex but all materials are very helpful in aiding comprehension. I enjoyed the quizzes a lot.

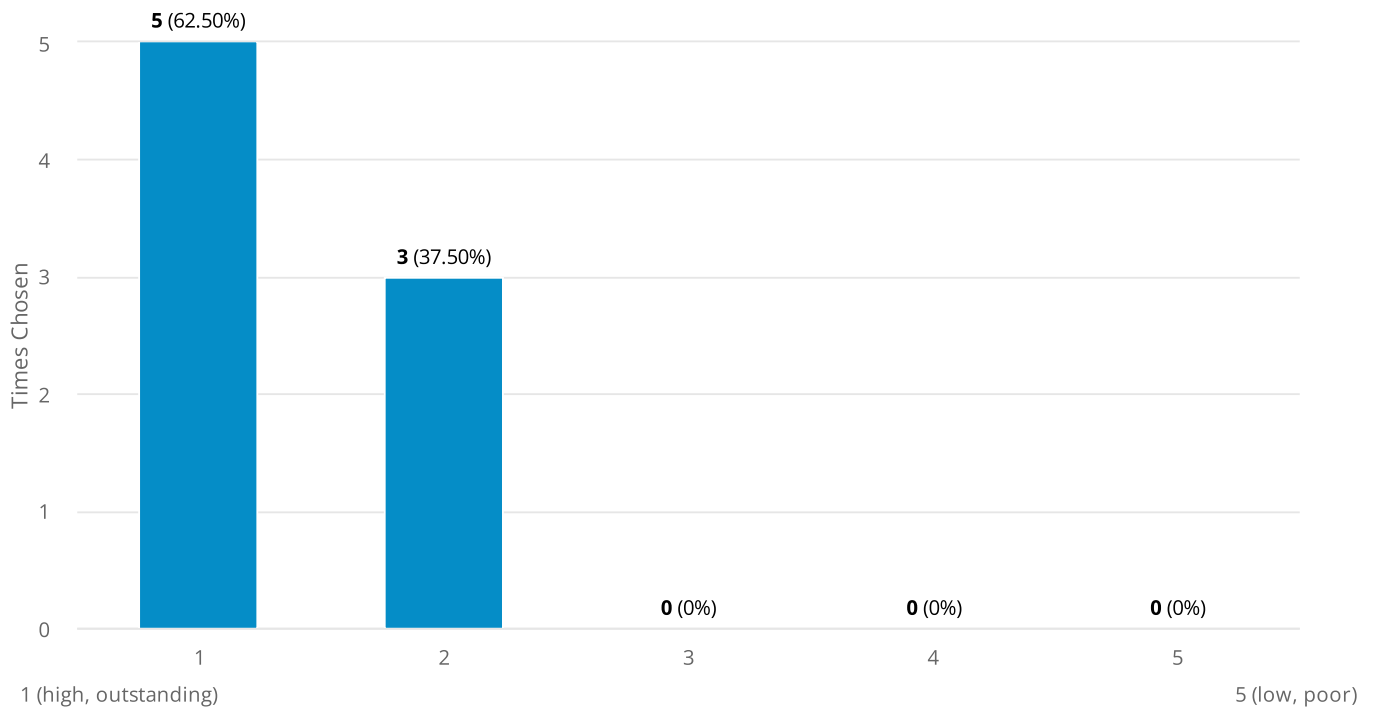
How consistently well prepared has the instructor been for classes?

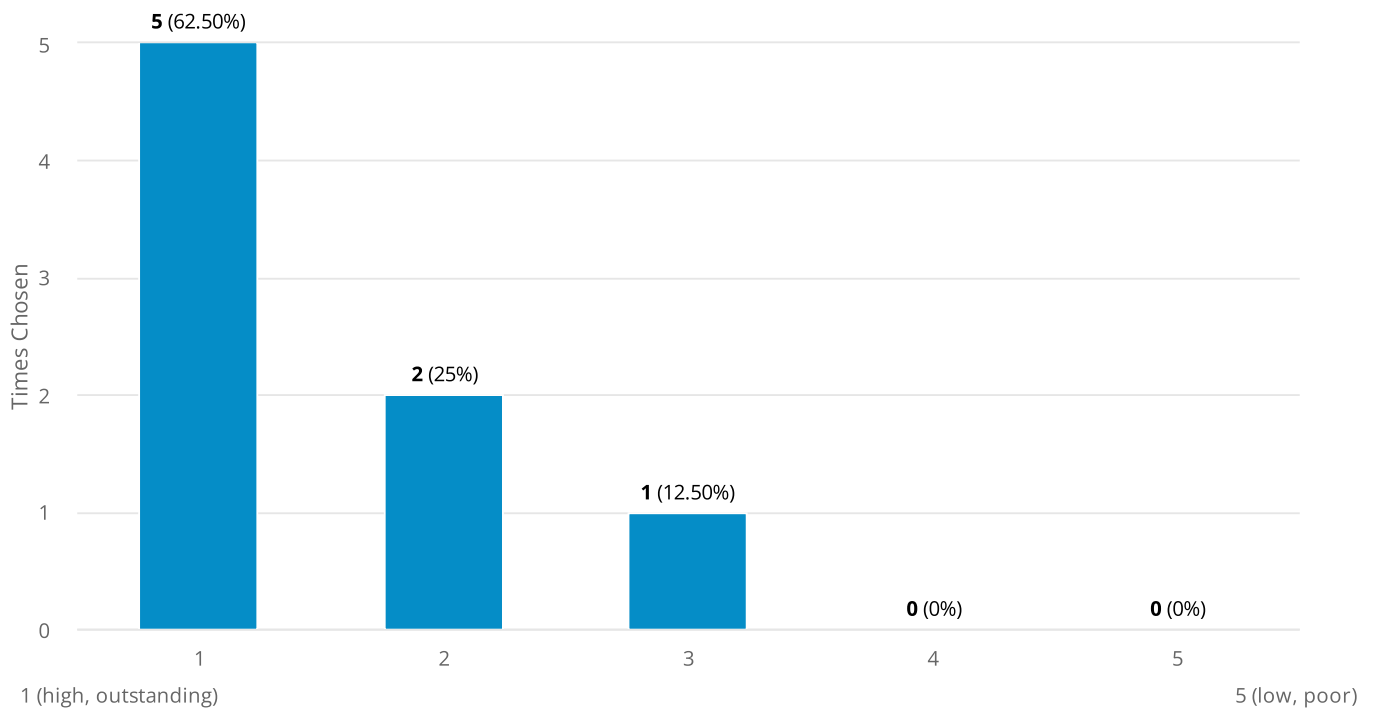

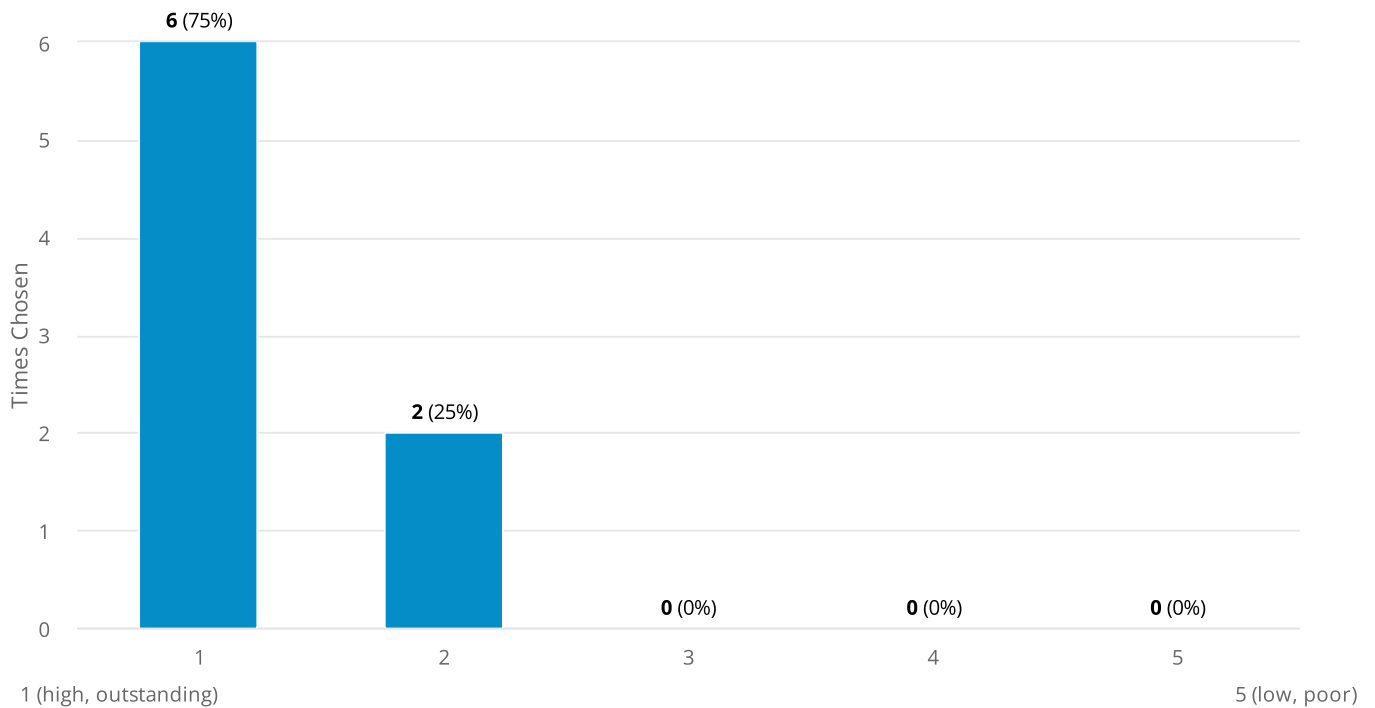

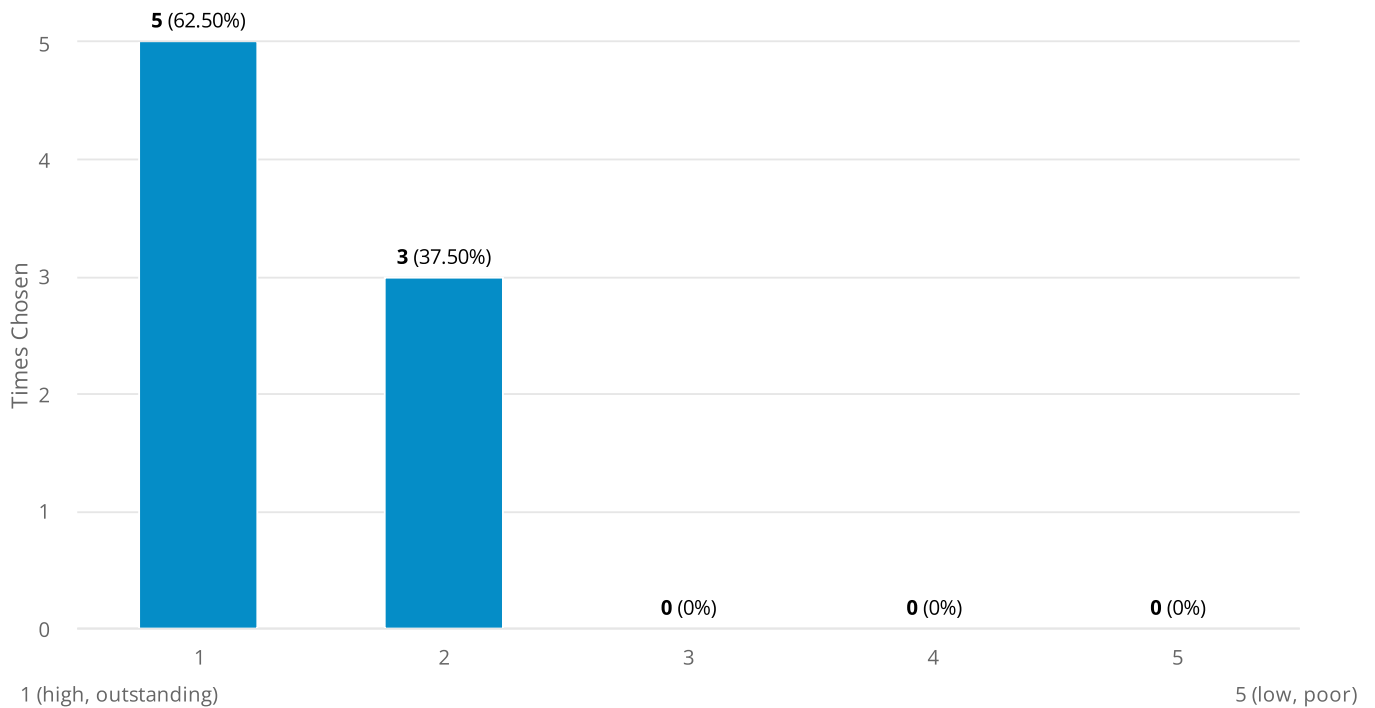

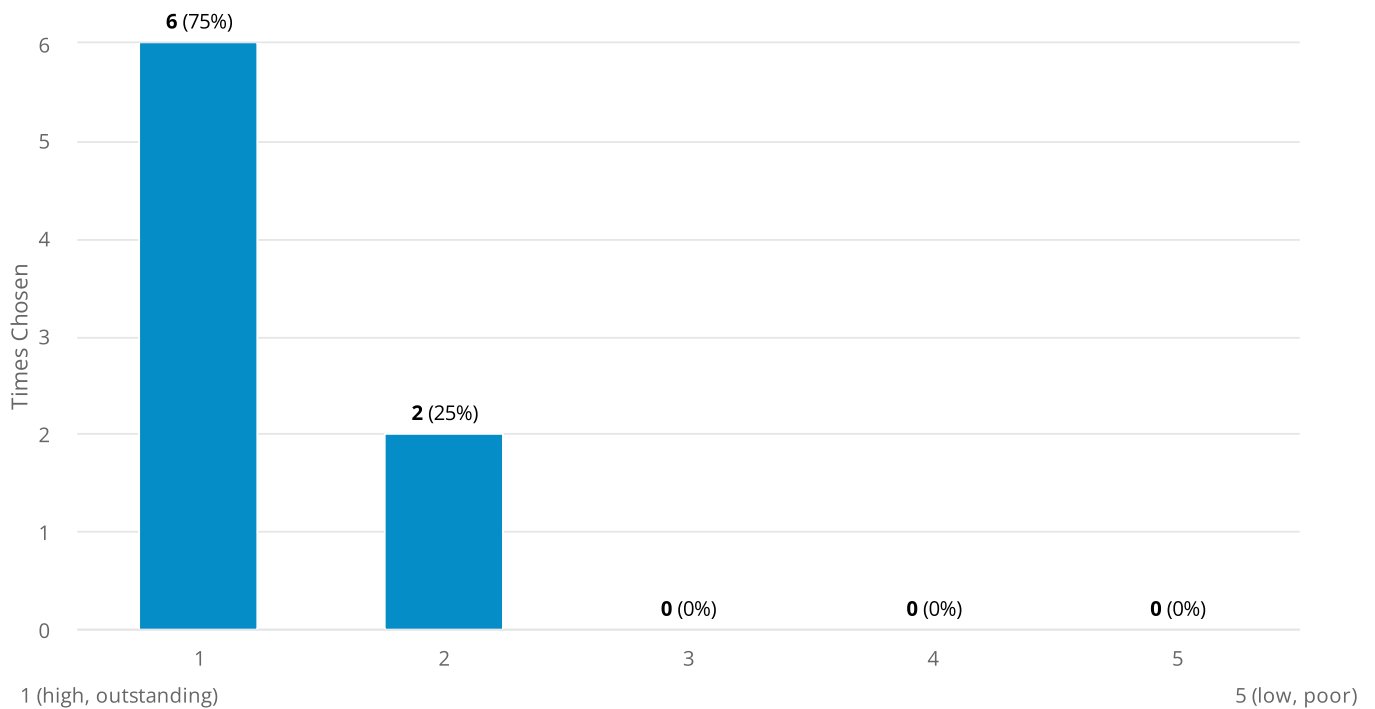
